Woodside is a purpose built resource centre opened in 1983 in Ross-on-Wye. Since December 2006 Woodside has been operating as Day Care Centre, providing 15 day care places Monday to Friday.

At Woodside the emphasis is on, encouraging people to regain some of the skills they may have lost through illness, social isolation or early stage dementia, and to provide an opportunity to give carers a break for the day, thus helping people to stay out of long term residential care.

Woodside Resource Centre employs friendly staff who are dedicated to a flexible day centre service, taking pride in a respectful service and pleasing atmosphere in which individuals can feel confident and at home.

The service is set up to improve the independence of the community's most vulnerable individuals, supporting respite for full-time carers and enabling people to meet and make friends rather than becoming isolated.

A range of recreational and leisure activities are organised on behalf of service users, with the service also looking to contribute to the development of life skills.
